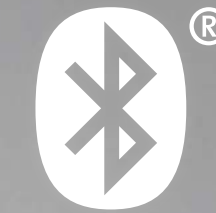
ACTON II Bluetooth®

ACTON II IS THE SMALLEST SPEAKER IN THE MARSHALL LINE-UP, BUT DON'T LET ITS SIZE FOOL YOU. THIS DYNAMIC COMPACT SPEAKER FEATURES THREE DEDICATED CLASS D AMPLIFIERS THAT POWER ITS DUAL TWEETERS AND SUBWOOFER, FOR A SOUND THAT IS NOTHING SHORT OF LARGE. IT PRODUCES A WELL BALANCED, POWERFUL AUDIO EXPERIENCE, YET CAN FIT IN THE TINIEST OF SPACES. WITH BLUETOOTH 5.0 TECHNOLOGY YOU CAN PLAY YOUR MUSIC IN GLORIOUS, STEREO SOUND WITH NO WIRES REQUIRED ■



LARGER THAN LIFE SOUND

Acton II is the smallest speaker in the Marshall line-up, but produces a sound that's nothing short of large. It delivers a well balanced, powerful audio experience, yet can fit in the tiniest of spaces. This dynamic compact speaker features three dedicated class D amplifiers that power its dual tweeters and subwoofer. The wooden cabinet construction helps provide a warm, natural sound and the bass reflex system includes a port to increase efficiency at low frequencies.



WIRELESSLY CONNECT WITH BLUETOOTH 5.0

Enjoy the freedom to move around your home and listen to your music, uninterrupted with Bluetooth 5.0. This technology provides lossless wireless sound at a range of up to 30 feet (10 metres) while maintaining connectivity. Use your Bluetooth enabled smartphone, tablet or computer to stream music directly to your speaker with no wires required.

ICONIC MARSHALL DESIGN

Classic Marshall details such as a textured vinyl covering, salt & pepper fret and the iconic script logo adorn this speaker's sturdy wooden frame. Located on the front of the speaker is a brass plate, etched with the establishment date of 1962 – a subtle nod to the brand's heritage and over 50 years of loud. You'll want to proudly display this speaker in any room.

CUSTOMISE YOUR SOUND

Fine-tune your music to meet your requirements. You can use the Marshall Bluetooth app or the analogue controls on your speaker's top panel to perfect your sound according to the room you're in. Adjust the volume, treble and bass with the brass knobs or use the Marshall Bluetooth app with the built-in equaliser in case you're out of reach.

WIRED CONNECTIVITY

There are more ways to connect than just Bluetooth 5.0. With the 3.5 mm input you can use a turntable, cassette deck or any other listening device for an analogue listening experience. Cable sold separately.
